



## Starting January 2026: Accept the Wellcare Spendables® Card via CareCredit

New in 2026, Wellcare members will be able to use their Medicare Advantage Wellcare Spendables® card to pay for eligible \* out-of-pocket dental expenses. To support this, we're excited to announce your practice will be able to process payments using the Wellcare Spendables card exclusively through CareCredit.

With nearly 1 million Wellcare Spendables cardholders\*\*, this new capability allows them to access additional funds to move forward with recommended care, and that means more potential revenue for your practice.

### What you need to know:

#### How do I accept the Wellcare Spendables card?

All transactions with the Wellcare Spendables card will need to be processed through CareCredit's provider portal, called Provider Center.

#### What is CareCredit?

CareCredit is a dedicated health and wellness credit card that offers flexible financing and is accepted at over 285,000 locations. We're partnering exclusively with CareCredit to process Wellcare Spendables card payments.

#### If my practice doesn't currently accept CareCredit and I can't access their Provider Center, what should I do?

Starting in **December**, we encourage you to enroll to accept CareCredit. This way, you'll be ready to opt-in to accept Wellcare Spendables card payments in January.

#### If my practice already accepts CareCredit, do I need to take any action now to accept the Wellcare Spendables card?

No action is required until January 2026, when you will need to opt-in to start accepting the Wellcare Spendables card. CareCredit will provide full details at that time.
